
FOR A SMALL NEW CLUB IT'S A MAMMOTH ACHEVEMENT.

YOUR JABIRU COMMITTEE ASK YOU TO PARTICIPATE IN SAFE CARAVAN TOWING

BY BEING AWARE OF ROAD ETIQUETTE.

OTHERWISE KNOW AS:-

<u>"TRUCKIES ETIQUETTE"</u>

The Lead vehicle regarded as " The Milkman" (First out)

* Know the destination.

*Be aware of the route.

* Set safe travel speed.

* Observe two hour drive time for fuel & comfort stops.

* Advise road oncoming hazards like road works & over width traffic.

<u>The following members</u> should be aware of safe travel distance between the vehicle in front (The code mentions a distance of no lest than 20 metres or two vehicle length. Road train route it mentions 200 m. *From my experience 300 metres at all times allows even Road trains to over take without having to brake or speed adjust.*

* Maintain The Milkman's travel speed.

* Be aware of his route direction & road condition reports as from the MILKMAN.

* In the event of the vehicle in front in counting the necessity to stop, you should stop & offer *assistance*. Note the remainder of the group are to continue on.

* You maybe given a convoy code name.

* From the leaders. (This allows you speak if the need to) Chatter is frowned on.

Finally the last convoy vehicle affectedly know as "Tail end Charlie or the Sweeper".

*Is responsible to advise vehicle over taking, such as emergency Fire, Ambulance & Police.

*And the well being of the group arrival.

* In emergency to stop with the vehicle/member so releasing the second stopped vehicle.

The Jabiru Club have agreed the above travel procedure is regarded as proven and safe travel policy & will be put into practice in route to the 2015 C.C.Rally & 2016 National Rally .


