There is a draft of new "Caravan Parks Act" in Western Australia proposing changes which will affect our members travelling in WA.

This is at the 2nd consultation stage with stake holders - mainly holiday park and camping ground owners. We have an opportunity to make a submission both as a club and as individuals.

The two proposals most affecting our members are:-

"Any person making available a campsite for an accommodation vehicle and/or tent will need approval if it will be available for use for any more than three nights in any 28 day period."

"Only one accommodation vehicle and/or tent is allowed on the property at any time without an event approval."

This means no gatherings in a friends' paddock, and no parking in the driveway of a relative/friend for a week or two. An event approval entails a cost and a management plan is to be submitted with application for such approval.

Gazetted roadside stops are exempt from this legislation as they come under the control of the Main Roads Department.

ATCM&CC will be submitting a document to the Department of Local Government and Communities (WA) objecting to these changes. Also, we urge members to make a submission individually. There will be a template on our website in the near future to assist you in this. Also, members in WA can contact their local WA MP if they wish to do so

This could be the thin edge of the wedge for other states to follow suit if this legislation is passed. Caravan Parks have a vested interest in these changes. Please help to make our voice heard. Your submission can be sent to caravan@dlgc.wa.gov.au or to

Winton had a big grin on his face too. Wishing you well.

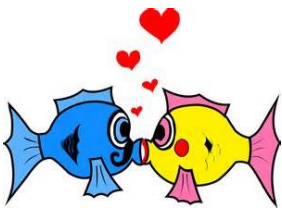

I have just been asked can you use Photos? Well why not but limit it to no more than three.

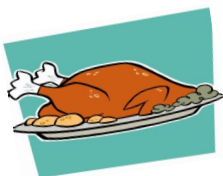
