well-attended rally by 19 Vans well done to all that attended but we still have a couple of members that were too ill to attend.

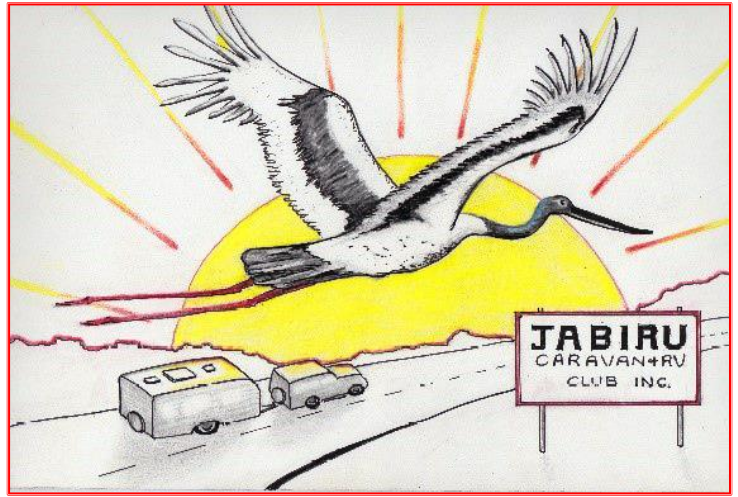
Best Wishes to Ted & Rhonda hope we will see you soon.

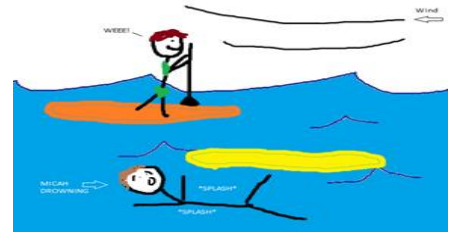

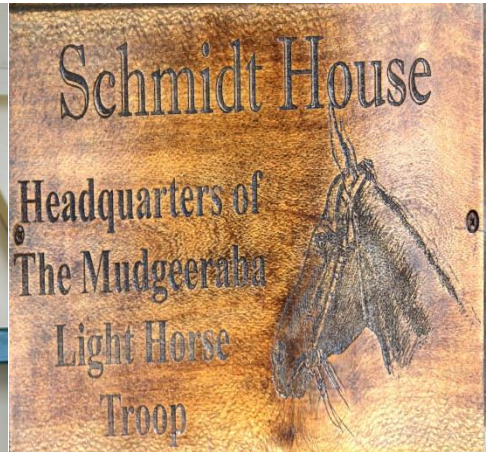
