TOOGOOLAWAH.

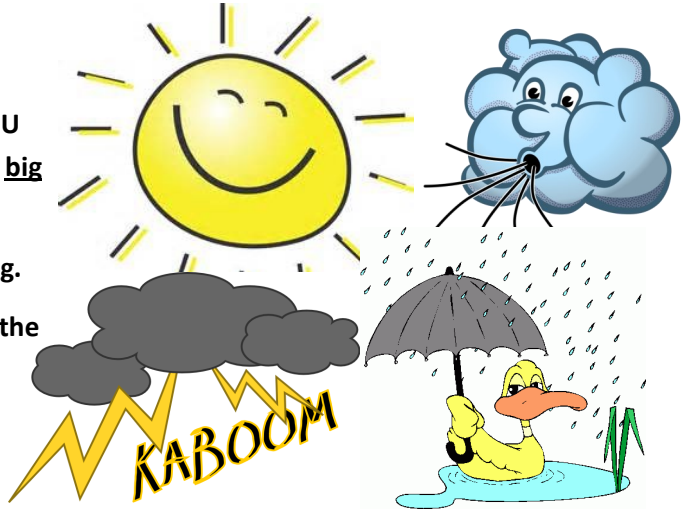
Our tent builders saved us from the heat, GREAT JOB YOU MEN. Then the midnight caper came along & we had the big wind. So it was pulled down real quick,

CARAVAN TYRE PRESSURES

Inflation Pressures

Caravan weight on two wheels	= 1200 Kg
20% safety margin	= 240 Kg.
Total load over two tyres	= 1440 Kg.
Load on each tyre	= 720 Kg.
Inflation pressure (see table above)	= 325 KPa. (47PSI)

Tyre Pressures –do- it-yourself check

It is impossible to list the correct pressures for every Caravan, due to variation in size, load, etc.

This easy check will help you find the best pressure for your Caravan Tyres.

- 1) First, inflate the tyres to the pressure recommended by the Manufacturer of the Van/trailer and the tyres you are using. Secondly, measure and record the cold start pressure before you start out. Tow your Van/Trailer for a distance of 100 km, preferably on a highway.
- 2) Recheck the tyre pressures immediately after pulling over and compare them with the cold start pressures you had at the start of your run. If the pressures are right, the hot readings should be 4 psi (28kPa) higher than the cold start readings.
- 3) If there is greater than 4 psi (28kPa) difference between these pressures, the tyre temperature is too high, caused by the cold start pressure being too low, so the pressure needs to be increased. If there is less than 4 psi (28kPa) difference, then the starting pressure is too high and needs to be lowered.
- 4) Large 4WD Tyres will have a differential of 6psi (42kPa).
- 5) Be sure to use the same accurate gauge for both readings.
