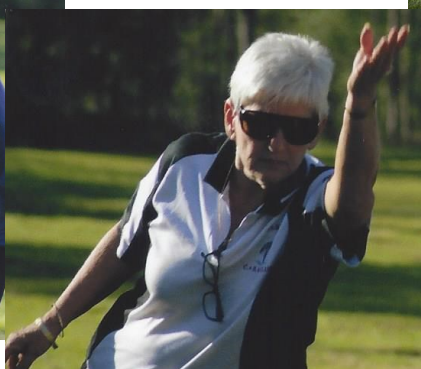

Legally restricted channels. ACMA. UHF.CB

Channel 5 & 35 are designated emergency channels & to be only used as such.

Use 5 with duplex on. If no response try with it off.

Channel 11 is the call channel to be used in initiating contact, then move to a vacant channel.

Channel 22 & 23 are only to be used for telemetry, telecommand, packet data. NO VOICE.

UHF Channels Each of 80 have the following accepted use.

1-8 & 41-48 Duplex output. 31—38 & 71-78 Duplex input. 5 & 35 emergency only.

9,12-17, 19-21 24-28,30,39,49-60, 60-70, 64-70 & 80 General chat

10 Regarded as 4WD DRIVE CLUBS, **18 CARAVAN & CAMPERS**, 40 TRUCKIES & OVERSIZED LOADS.

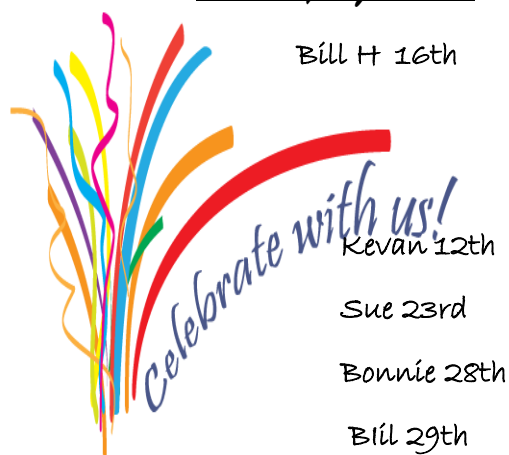
