We see ourselves as locals and as such our business is aimed at the local market.



<u>DIRECTIONS TO Kilkivan Bush Camp</u>: Follow Bruce Highway north to Gympie. About 30kms north of Gympie turn left to Wide Bay Highway / State Route 49. Follow Wide Bay Highway for about 32km, then turn left onto Spencer Road. Continue on Spencer Road for about 2.2km then turn left onto Rossmore Road. After about 2.4km along Rossmore Road you will arrive at Kilkivan Bush Camp, 577 Rossmore Road Kilkivan. (Use GPS at your own risk as the directions are not clear on them and you may get lost.)

Things you need to know for the next rally about Kilkivan Bush Camp:

- Kilkivan Bush Camp Phone Number (07) 5484 1340
- Camp site fee's \$30.00 per night with power & water 4th night free.
- Each member / Couple is to contact Kilkivan Bush Camp to book in & pay a deposit of 2 days
