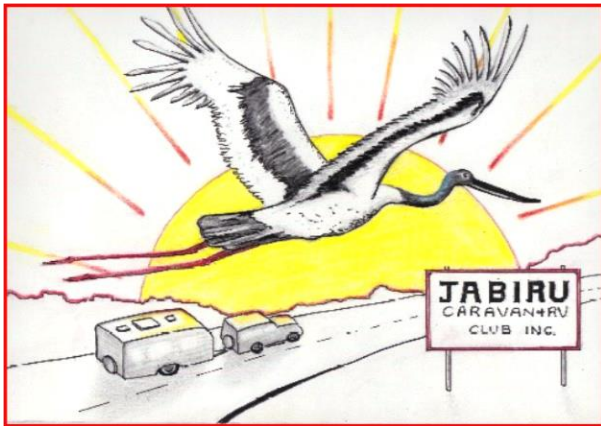

Kandanga

Kandanga is a small town in the Mary Valley south of Gympie. The area surrounding the Club campground was all lush green trees and the campground was also grass, which helped to keep things a bit cleaner.
