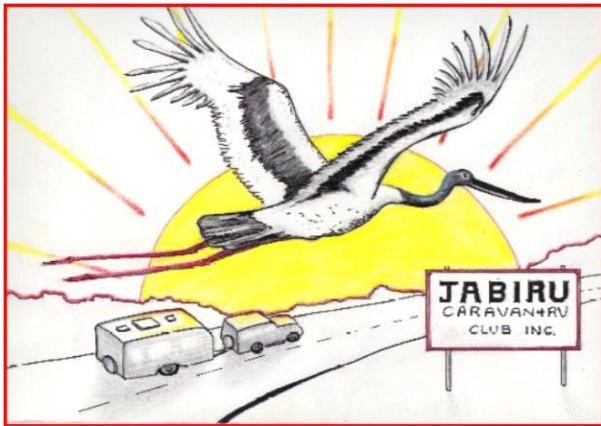


# STORK TALK

**Fay has sent us the following report on the State Rally together with photos -**

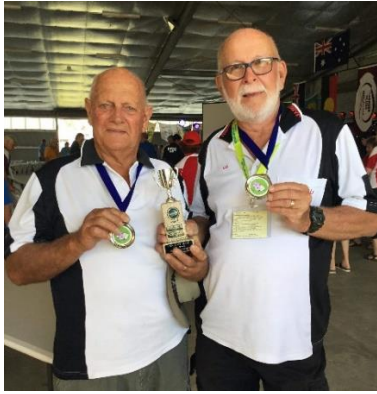

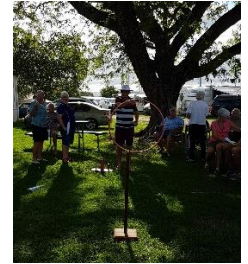
