TYRE PRESSURES FOR YOUR VAN

The correct tyre pressure is essential for both safety and economy.

Below are two methods to help you ensure you have the correct pressures

This is a Simple Method of calculating your vans tyre pressures borrowed from Caravan World Magazine.

Inflation pressure (see table above)	= 325 KPa (47 PSI)
